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FEED BACK STUDY ON STUDENT TEACHER INTERACTION FOR BATCH 2016 AND BATCH 2017

Level of teacher student interaction during theory lectures was ascertained from both the batches. 27(45%) students of 2016 batch rated teacher student interaction ≥4 on Likert scale, whereas, 51(69.86%) students of 2017 batch rated teacher student interaction ≥4 on Likert scale. This shows that interaction between students and teachers during the classes is increasing.
